



Virginia Resources Authority Summer Internship Program

The Virginia Resources Authority (VRA) is the municipal bond bank for Virginia, representing more than \$7 billion of investment in over 1,000 critical projects across the Commonwealth since its creation by the General Assembly in 1984. With its mission to provide innovative, cost-effective and sustainable financial solutions to build vibrant and healthy Virginia communities, VRA offers low cost loans for a number of project areas, including local government buildings, public safety, transportation, dam safety, wastewater, drinking water, solid waste, storm water drainage, federal facility development and brownfield remediation projects, among others.

The VRA Summer Internship Program is a paid program for individuals looking for career-related experience in public finance. Work exposure is afforded in multiple areas, including credit review, statistics, research and data analysis.

Requirements:

- Enrollment in, or recent graduate of, a Bachelor's or Master's degree program at an accredited college or university
- Coursework in finance, economics, accounting, statistics or related field
- Current Junior standing or above
- Self-starter with strong analytical and quantitative skills who can work independently and in teams
- Strong oral and written communication skills

Duration:

- Internship program will not exceed September 2, 2016
- Up to 40 hours per week for the duration of the program
- VRA will work with the intern to design a schedule that is workable for both VRA and the intern
